

Mr. Kenny Sailors came to Angoon High School in the fall of 1987. I had the pleasure of working with Mr. Sailors in my capacities of athletic director for three seasons. Kenny did a superb job of coaching the varsity girls basketball team. During the 1987-88 season he took a young and inexperienced squad under his wings and guided them to a 16 and 5 record. His 1988-89 team finished 18 and 5. In 1989-90 his team had a 19-5 record while winning the conference, the Region V "AA" tournament, and a fourth place finish in the state tournament in Anchorage. In his three years at Angoon High School his teams won fifty-three times and lost only fifteen.
